Petitioning of new substances

When using new components in Food Contact Materials, manufacturers have to submit a petition to the relevant authorities. In order to get a component listed or authorised for FCM, the component must be demonstrated to be safe for human health. TRISKELION can perform the required migration tests, toxicological risk assessment along with dossier preparation and submission to the respective authorities.
